## Re: 2024 Saskatchewan Provincial Taekwondo Championship – Melville Sask on Nov 23, 2024

The updated information will be on the website in late September, as soon as we fine tune this year's version of the On-Line registration.

<u>We have one main host Hotel</u>. This is the "Sigma Inn & Suites" just 10 minutes from the venue, across the street from MC Donald's/ Tim Hortons on Hi-way SK-10. Use booking code "Taekwondo Provincials" for our special rate. A block has been set aside until November 1, 2024.

There are numerous other hotels available in Melville as well as in Yorkton. Yorkton is just a 20 minutes' drive from the venue. Please Google for information and prices that suit your needs. Please book early on account of the many different activities booked for Yorkton that quickly fill the available vacancies. We would suggest that you book hotels by mid to late October.

For Kyorugi, we will offer <u>Single Elimination competition format</u> with the new <u>"Best of 3 Rounds Decision"</u> for all colored and black belts, we know this will assist the instructors and athletes in their goals to acquire experience for the developing athletes. Unfortunately, we will not allow Black belt juniors to enter both the Junior and Senior division. They will have to choose one or the other. The Recreational Poomsae competition will be a head to head competition with a double elimination option. This format proved to be very popular in past Poomsae competitions. Black Belt Sport Competition Poomsae will be scored and announced as per WT Rules and KPnP Scoring System. Black Belts must choose "Rec" or "Sport" not both. The "both" option is for Kyorugi plus a Poomsae option.

All Athletes, except for Blackbelts, will be scored with Daedo judges clickers only. This group will need to also bring your own <u>WT Approved</u> head gear, Hogos and instep protectors. We plan to utilize <u>Daedo electronic PSS scoring and Daedo E-head gear for the black belts only.</u> You need to bring your own Daedo E-Socks.

<u>Entry forms</u> and <u>entry fees</u> must be received in Melville before Noon Sunday November 17, 2024. We are trying on-line registration and payment this year or you will make an E-transfer to melvilletkd@gmail.com with the password "provincials". Those registration instructions to follow soon in the official information package. All late entry forms will be subject to an additional \$20 late registration fee. Please ensure that all data is complete and accurate. Incomplete or grossly inaccurate data will be considered for the late fee.

<u>Weigh-ins</u> will be conducted on the night of November 22<sup>nd</sup>, timing will be announced soon on the provincial tournament website. There may be random weigh-ins on Saturday at Venue.

A <u>meeting of coaches</u> if required is scheduled for Saturday morning to explain how our event will proceed so that your competitors can be informed of the staging process. Confirm this on Friday Evening at Melville Taekwondo on CN Community Centre.
